WHAT'S MIXED MEDIA?

• THE USE OF A VARIETY OF MEDIA

- MEDIA/MEDIUM IS WHAT YOU USE TO CREATE YOUR ARTWORK
- PENCIL, PEN, COLORED PENCIL, MARKER, CHARCOAL, GRAPHITE, ACRYLIC, OIL PAINT, WATERCOLOR, CLAY, WIRE, PLASTER, NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINE, ETC.

WHAT'S A COLLAGE?

- DIFFERENT FROM COLLEGE
- FRENCH FOR "TO GLUE"
- TECHNIQUE IN ART WHERE ARTWORKS ARE MADE FROM AN ASSEMBLAGE OF DIFFERENT FORMS OR SHAPES, THUS CREATING A NEW WHOLE.


THEREFORE....














WORKING FOR A CAUSE





FOR YOUR PROJECT...

- You will be creating a mixed-media collage for a cause
 - THINK ABOUT THE DIFFERENT CAUSES THAT SPEAK TO YOU (CANCER, ABORTION, EQUAL RIGHTS, ETC.)
 - BRAINSTORM WITH AT LEAST 5 IDEAS
- YOUR MIXED-MEDIA COLLAGE WILL PORTRAY YOUR MESSAGE TO AN AUDIENCE

FOR YOUR PROJECT...

- THINK ABOUT WHAT YOU WANT TO CREATE
- BEGIN SKETCHING YOUR 5 IDEAS, BE SURE TO LABEL WHAT MEDIUMS WILL BE GOING INTO THE PROJECT AND WHERE.
 - MIXED-MEDIA = A VARIETY OF MEDIUMS (PENCIL, WATERCOLORS, SHARPIE, MAGAZINES, SCRAP PAPER, RECYCLED MATERIALS SUCH AS CARDBOARD, ETC.)

ONCE YOU HAVE IT, BEGIN SKETCHING SOME IDEAS: 5 SKETCHES =
 1 FORMATIVE GRADE DUE TOMORROW – TAKE YOUR TIME!

WHEN FINISHED SKETCHING...

- SHOW THE TEACHER FOR YOUR FORMATIVE GRADE.
- DISCUSS YOUR IDEAS AND USE OF MATERIALS/MEDIUM TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT.
 - WITH THE TEACHER AND THE STUDENTS IN THE ROOM!
 FEEDBACK IS IMPORTANT!
- BEGIN YOUR FINAL PROJECT ON 11" X 14" PAPER
- COMPLETE YOUR ARTIST STATEMENT FOR 100 SUMMATIVE POINTS
- THE TEACHER WILL ALSO GRADE YOU ON YOUR GRADING RUBRICS

ARTIST STATEMENT

- Two paragraphs MINIMUM
 - IN THE FIRST, DISCUSS YOUR CAUSE/IDEA.
 - Why did you choose it? Does it hold a special place in your heart? Does it mean something to you or someone you know?
 - IN THE SECOND, DISCUSS YOUR PROCESS
 - WHAT STEPS DID YOU TAKE IN ORDER TO CREATE YOUR ARTWORK? TALK ABOUT THE PROCESS OF CREATING YOUR WORK OF ART (THE STEPS YOU TOOK). REFLECT ON YOUR ARTWORK'S SUCCESSFUL AREAS. POINT OUT AREAS OF INTEREST/FOCAL POINTS, ETC.
